PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Designed with a soft, upholstered seat- and backrest and a flexible swivel base, the chair offers a comfortable seating experience for a variety of uses. Slender armrests continue straight into the padded backrest, giving the chair an almost airy expression despite of its solid components. The seat rests on a pillar that branches out in a 4-legged base on either non-slip castor wheels or floor gliders allowing for a 360° seat rotation.

For additional protection of the chair frame, a set of felt strips is included. Place the strips underneath the edge of the abutting table.

Materials

Solid frame in cast powder-coated or polished aluminium and upholstery of protected aniline leather. To protect hard flooring, replaceable feet with a welded felt pad are available as an additional purchase.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Frame

Keep the chair frame surfaces clean and dry. Vipp products with powder-coated surfaces should be cleaned with a lint-free, soft brush and, if stained, with a bit of water warm water and mild cleaning agent. Finish by wiping down the surface with a dry cloth. For polished surfaces, use a polishing cloth to recall the shining effect. Do not use coarse cloths or detergents that may scratch the polished surface.

Upholstery

We recommend caring for the upholstery of your Vipp chair to ensure its long-lasting appeal and appearance. A few simple directions will help preserve the upholstery for generations. Please note that natural patina will appear over time.

Leather

Avoid exposing the upholstery to direct sunlight, excessive heat, or sharp objects.
Use a clean, dry cloth to absorb spills.
Use a vacuum cleaner with a soft brush twice a month for regular dust removal.
Do not use household detergents, ammonia, oils, polishes, varnishes, etc.

Avoid bar soap, saddle soap and leather cleaners
For bi-annual thorough cleaning, clean the leather with soap flakes

Cleaning with soap flakes:

1. Use ½ deciliter of soap flakes for a liter of hot water. Whip the soap flakes into the water.
2. When the water reaches room temperature, apply the foam all over the upholstery with a soft cloth. Only use the foam, not the water, and avoid soaking the leather.
3. When the leather is dry, polish it with a soft, dry cotton cloth.

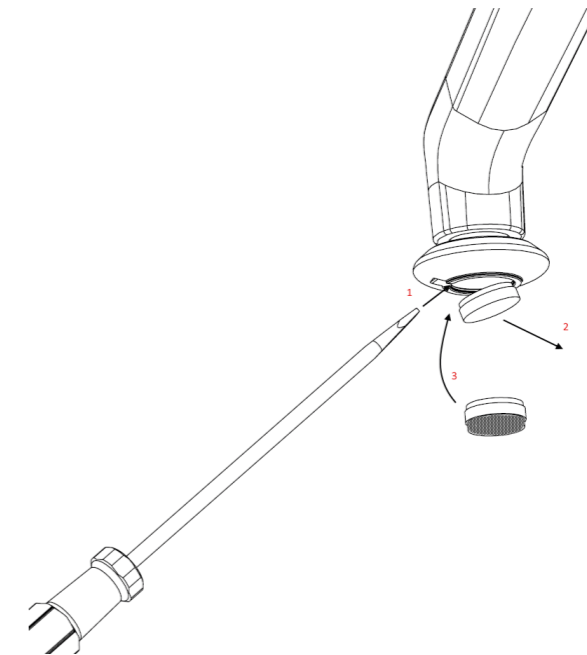
WARRANTY

MAINTENANCE GUIDE

For protection of hard flooring, felt pads can be purchased as an additional purchase. To replace the felt feet, please follow the instructions below.

1. Use a screwdriver for unhinging the old insert.
2. Insert the new felt pad and place the leg on the floor or a flat surface.
3. Press down the leg on the felt pad to fasten it firmly into place.

The chair is not approved for heavy office use. Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture tip-over. Do not tilt while sitting on the chair.
